



HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

1 HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK ACT 1974

1.1 Section 2(3) of the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 (HASAWA) states that "...it shall be the duty of every employer to prepare and as often as may be appropriate revise a written statement of his general policy with respect to the health and safety at work of his employees and the organisation and arrangements for the time being in force for carrying out that policy, and to bring the statement and any revision of it to the notice of his employees..."
